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Pretty Poinsettias Make Ideal Christmas Accent

Poinsettias may be the perfect plant for the Christmas season. In their native Mexico, the poinsettia's bright red flowers are known as Flores de la Noche Buena, or Flowers of the Holy Night, as they bloom each year during the Christmas season.

Poinsettias come in colors to fit almost any decoration scheme. There is the traditional bright red, but I really like the whites, pinks and marbled bicolors, too. There are rose-flowered selections, and

if that's not enough, growers even paint them and add sparkles.

More growers and florists use poinsettias in combination con-

tainers. For many years, Southern Gardening has promoted combining the poinsettia with Mississippi Medallion winner Diamond Frost

euphorbia. Both plants are in the euphorbia family and have similar care requirements. The contrasting poinsettia colors and the white Diamond Frost are really attractive.

One question I get every year involves the poinsettia's "flowers," which are actually modified leaves called bracts. The true flowers are yellow-green, bead-like structures called cyathia. Your poinsettia will last longer if you select a plant with unopened or partially opening cyathia. You can even carefully remove these structures for longer lasting color.

When poinsettia shopping, don't be tempted to grab the first plants you see. Take your time to find that perfect plant. Poinsettias are fragile, and the stems are brittle. Even with careful handling at the greenhouse, stems can be broken when the sleeves are put

on, and the damage may not be readily noticeable.

Pay attention when removing the paper or plastic sleeves that can hide damage. Never try to slide the shipping sleeves off because you could damage the plant. Always carefully tear or cut the sleeve off.

One of the most widely reported urban legends at this time of year is that poinsettias are poisonous to our pets. This is not the case, but no ornamentals or houseplants are meant to be eaten by our animals, so try to keep the poinsettia out of your pet's reach.

Some humans, myself included, may be sensitive to the milky, latex sap in the poinsettia, which can cause a skin rash or contact dermatitis. To prevent this problem, always wash your hands thoroughly after handling a poinsettia.

To help keep your poinsettia looking good long after the Christmas holidays, make sure it gets at least six hours of indirect sunlight a day, and keep it at a comfortable room temperature. If you're comfortable, your poinsettias will be, too.

Don't let the leaves or bracts touch the window glass as the cold outside will transfer through the glass and hurt the plant. Poinsettias look great by the front door when guests arrive, but to keep them looking good, avoid the sudden temperature changes from drafts as the door is opened.

Be sure to brighten your Christmas celebrations with several of your favorite poinsettias.

Delicious Christmas Day Brunch Ideas



Brunch Eggs

- 12 thin Canadian bacon slices
- 3 4-ounce packages shredded Swiss cheese
- 12 large eggs
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon paprika
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley

Place bacon in a single layer in a lightly greased 13 x 9 -inch baking dish; sprinkle with Swiss cheese. Cover and chill, if desired. Break eggs over cheese, spacing evenly. Pour whipping cream over eggs, and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Bake at 425 degrees for 10 minutes. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and paprika. Bake 8 to 10 more minutes or until set. Remove from oven; sprinkle with parsley. Let stand 10 minutes before serving. Note: Casserole may be divided into 12 portions and served on English muffins.

Creamy Grits Casserole

- 1 1/4 cups uncooked regular grits
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 2 cups milk
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground red pepper
- 1/2 cup butter, cut into cubes
- 1 10-ounce block sharp Cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 4-ounce smoke Gouda cheese round, shredded
- 2 large eggs, lightly beaten

Bring grits, chicken broth, milk, salt and red pepper to a boil in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat; reduce heat to low, and simmer, stirring occasionally, 4 to 5 minutes or until thickened. Stir in butter and cheese until melted. Gradually stir about one-fourth hot grits mixture into eggs; add egg mixture to remaining hot grits mixture, stirring constantly. Pour grits mixture into a lightly greased 2 1/2-quart baking dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 35 to 40 minutes or until golden brown and bubbly around edges. Let stand 5 minutes before serving.

Cornmeal-and-Brown Sugar Cruled Bacon

- 1/4 cup plain yellow cornmeal
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 1/2 teaspoons freshly ground pepper
- 16 thick bacon slices

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Combine the cornmeal, brown sugar, and pepper in a shallow dish. Dredge bacon slices in cornmeal mixture, shaking off excess. Place half of bacon in a single layer on a lightly greased wire rack in a jelly-roll pan. Repeat procedure with remaining bacon. Bake for 40 to 50 minutes or until browned and crisp. Let stand 5 minutes.

Cranberry-Orange Bread

- 1 cup nutlike cereal nuggets
- 1 cup uncooked regular oats
- 1/2 cup whole wheat flour
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup nonfat buttermilk
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon grated orange rind
- 1/2 cup low-sugar orange marmalade
- 1/2 cup sweetened dried cranberries

Combine the first 6 ingredients in a large bowl; make a well in the center of mixture. Whisk together buttermilk, oil, and eggs; add to dry mixture, stirring just until moistened. Gently fold in grated orange rind, marmalade, and cranberries. Spoon into a lightly greased 8 1/2 x 4 1/2 -inch loaf pan. Bake at 375 degrees for 28 to 32 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pan on wire rack 5 minutes. Remove from pan to wire rack, and let cool 20 minutes or until completely cool.

Sunshine Citrus Platter

- 4 navel oranges
- 2 Ruby Red or Rio Star grapefruit
- 2 tablespoons powdered sugar
- Ground cinnamon
- Garnish: fresh mint leaves

Peel oranges and grapefruit; cut into 1/2 -inch rounds. Cover and chill 1 to 24 hours. Arrange fruit on a large platter. Sift powdered sugar over fruit; sprinkle with cinnamon. Serve immediately.

Rich 'n' Thick Hot Chocolate

- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 4 cups milk, divided
- 2 3.5-ounce dark chocolate bars, chopped (at least 70% cacao)
- 1/3 cup honey
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Pinch of salt

Whisk together cornstarch and 1/2 cup milk until smooth. Cook remaining 3 1/2 cups milk in a large, nonaluminum saucepan over medium heat until bubbles appear around edge of saucepan (about 4 minutes; do not boil). Whisk in chocolate, honey, vanilla extract, and salt until blended and smooth. Whisk in cornstarch mixture. Bring milk mixture to a light boil, whisking frequently (about 4 minutes). Remove from heat. Let cool slightly (mixture will thicken as it cools). Serve immediately with marshmallows or whipped cream, if desired.



Oh, Christmas Tree

After Thanksgiving, it is time to put up the Christmas tree. From my earliest memory of having a Christmas tree, I remember the highlight of unpacking the ornaments (at least for me), was plugging in the chirping bird ball. And my Momma or Daddy would quickly un-plug it. The sound is difficult to describe, but it is definitely an early electronic sound. A bit of a high pitched twill followed by a series of chirps that repeats itself over and over and over. I just loved it; I am pretty sure the rest of my family wished that bird ball would get lost in the attic.

I also remember that our Christmas tree was always an Eastern Red Cedar. Daddy would take us out in the little wooden wagon behind the 1952 8N Ford Tractor with the chain saw in tow. We would search the woods for the perfect tree, collect it, and drag it home in the wagon. We would decorate it with handmade ornaments my brothers and I had made and things Momma had collected over the years, like the three little red mice that always hung together on a branch.

Some years later, when my husband and I lived in Wyoming, we would purchase a Christmas tree tag and 'go up the mountain' to get our tree. It would be a spruce. And the tradition of unpacking the ornaments continued, this time with the collection I had started. I am still working on that collection, and I am sure my girls will add to it with things made from construction paper and cardboard.

The sale of Christmas trees is big business. They are grown in all 50 states including Hawaii and Alaska. In Mississippi, they are part of the list of horticulture crops that include vegetables, melons, potatoes, fruits, tree nuts, berries, nursery, greenhouses, floriculture, and sod. These crops cumulatively rank twelfth in commodity production accounting for a \$115 million industry.

The tradition of the Christmas tree is really not that old. The first record of a tree being on display was in the 1830s by the German settlers of Pennsylvania. By the 1890s, Christmas ornaments were arriving from Germany and Christmas tree popularity increased. In the early 20th century, Americans decorated their trees mainly with homemade ornaments, apples, nuts, and popcorn.

Small Town, Mississippi, at the Ag Museum portrays the 1920s era. It was during this time period that people began to light their trees electrically. Before 1900, lighting a Christmas tree with electric lights was practically unheard of. If they were lit at all, it was with candles or glass candle cups.

Although the Ag Museum Coun-

The Ag Museum is open to the public again, and the damaged buildings have been cleaned up. Words simply cannot express the feeling of blessing and gratitude we have for all of those who came to our aid with dump trucks, track hoes, food, and gloves on hands ready to sort through the ashes. Now it is time to start the process of rebuilding.

Yes, we will be talking about that fire for some time. But, it is truly evident by the outpouring of support we received, that the people of Mississippi love the Ag Museum and want to see it preserved for generations to come.

The fire of 2014 is now part of our history. Temporary displays of recovered artifacts may be viewed at the Mississippi Farmers Market and on the Ag Museum grounds until our facilities can accommodate them again.

Although we do have insurance, there are many additional needs. Your donation will allow the Mississippi Ag Museum Foundation to purchase immediate necessities, rebuild facilities we lost, as well as to implement our master plan goals. The Ag Museum belongs to the peo-



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Quick, Healthy Food Gifts Make Holidays Brighter

Holiday gift giving can feel overwhelming when everyone seems to have the necessities and the budget is tight.

Natasha Haynes, a Mississippi State University Extension Service agent in Rankin County, said one easy solution is to give homemade food gifts.

"Everybody has to eat, and food gifts do not have to be expensive or high in calories," Haynes said. "From homemade granola to jars filled with ingredients for a pot of healthy soup, good gifts are limited only by your creativity."

With so much information available online, frugal gift-givers can find plenty of clever ideas, recipes and suggestions for gifts that will please even the most hard-to-buy-for person on the Nice List.

"The advantages of making soup mixes with dry ingredients, such as beans and pasta, are the ability to control sodium and fat while providing a high-protein, high-fiber meal that is shelf stable," Haynes said. "Some recipes call for canned tomatoes or other canned goods, and you can make a gift basket that includes no- or low-sodium options to give your friends and family a healthy, quick meal option."

Haynes, who is also the host of the TV segment "The Food Factor," said high-fiber pastas and broth-based recipes, rather than cream-based recipes, keep the final product from being loaded with empty calories.

"Another tip to remember is, if you give someone a mix and they need to add other ingredients to it, try to select recipes that feature commonly stocked pantry items," she said. "You want your present to be something your friends will use and enjoy, not something that causes stress because they need to make an extra trip to the grocery

store."

When it comes to saving money, gifts in a jar can be economical, depending on recipes and packaging.

"Dried beans and lentils are one of the most affordable foods available," said Theresa Hand, Extension county coordinator in Hinds County. "Buy beans and other ingredients in bulk. Then you can spend one evening filling jars and making seasoning packets and have several gifts ready to deliver. The holidays are so hectic and filled with rich sweets, but everyone can use a hearty, simple soup for those nights when they don't feel like cooking."

Hand said partnering with a friend or two to create these kinds of practical gifts can make the assembly process faster and more fun.

"One person can fill jars while the others make spice packets, prepare recipe cards, or decorate the jars,"

she said. "Pooling your resources can also help cut costs. Plus, it's a great way to spend some time together, which is what the holidays are really about."

Cookie and muffin mixes that require oatmeal, whole wheat flour, or reduced amounts of sugar can also be healthy, helpful gifts.

"Look for muffin recipes that use applesauce instead of oil and include dried fruit, wheat germ or bran," Hand said. "By reducing fat and adding fiber, you can help your friends fight off holiday weight gain. Plus, when your friends have unexpected company, a quick homemade mix on the shelf can be a lifesaver. You might want to keep a jar or two for yourself."

Checklist for Winterizing the Farm

No matter the size of your farm, big or small, preparing for winter is essential to keep things running smoothly and ensuring your animals stay safe and healthy. On a farm, there are not as many people to get the work done, so preparation and organization is key to surviving any season, especially winter.

Providing your farm machinery with proper care such as cleaning, maintenance, and storage over the winter will increase its reliability and performance as well as increase its retail value. Plus, when spring comes, you will have a quicker start-up time, getting ready to go on spring chores as soon as possible.

To make sure you don't forget anything, here is a helpful checklist for winterizing your farm:

Barn Cleaning - The barn may get crowded over time of months, so its time to clean out your barns and buildings. Remove all debris, trash, and safely store any flammable items you may have.

Inspections and Repairs - Check the farm for any necessary repairs - this includes fences, barn and shelter roofs, stalls, and pastures. Have extra fencing supplies on hand in case you need to make repairs during winter from fallen trees or ice damage.


Water - Fresh water all year long is essential to the health of your animals. Check your supplies and plan for freezing temperatures. Here are some items you may need: stock tanks, pond de-icers, cattle waterers, and/or cattle fountains.

Heat Lamps/Bulbs - Make sure your heat lamps are working properly and keep a few extra bulbs on hand.

Feeders - Many animals can't get enough to eat foraging through the winter months, so you will need to supplement with hay or feed. Whatever you need - hay feeders, bunk feeders, creep feeders, or stock tanks, make sure you have the equipment and supplies necessary.

Salt For Walkways - Slick and icy paths can be treacherous to humans and animals too. Stock up on salt and keep it accessible to use often during freezing temperatures.

First Aid Kit For Animals - Keep a first aid kit in the barn. Include medicines, vitamins, and bandages. During a winter storm, the vet may not be able to travel to the farm right away so you should keep a few sup-



plies on hand.

Calf Supplies - If you are expecting calves to be born during the winter, stock up on your calf health supplies now.

Fill Tanks - Condensation often occurs when weather warms in the spring, which can cause water to enter empty tanks. Top off fuel and hydraulic oil tanks to eliminate this problem. Store DEF in its original container during winter. Plug the tank vent and keep the container away from heat and direct sunlight.

Adequately Lubricate Equipment - Consult the operator instruction book and lubricate as recommended. Grease unpainted metal parts (example - hydraulic cylinder rods) to protect them from the elements.

Repair Damaged Equipment - Fix any damage that occurred the past season. This ensures that broken parts don't further degrade or rust during the winter. It also ensures faster access to equipment when it's needed next spring or summer.

Maintain and Clean Equipment - Remove dust and debris from both inside and outside of farm equipment. Change oil and fluids, and check tire air pressure regularly. Protect the air inlet and exhaust from humidity. Lower each linkage fully to avoid pressure buildup in hydraulic rams. If possible, slacken the engine accessories' belt tensioner. Remove the battery and store in a dry location.

Store Equipment - Keeping equipment under a roof is the best way to protect equipment, but this is not always possible. If left outdoors, cover equipment and protect computerized mechanisms with a cloth. Using water-resistant products such as wax can further protect equipment from rust and premature wear.

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
