Newly Planted Christmas Trees Hampered by Weather

Christmas tree growers in Mississippi expect a seven percent increase in sales this year, but unfavorable spring and fall weather may hurt future supplies.

Stephen Dicke, a forestry professor with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said growers successfully controlled insect and disease problems this year. However, a wet spring followed by a dry summer and early fall caused some growers to lose up to half of their one-year-old trees.

"During the first half of the

year, we had a number of foliage diseases spread by excessive rain and high aphid and white fly insect populations," Dicke said. "The older trees tended to survive the drought we saw more recently, but they quit growing for a while. The recent rains have really perked up the trees and got them ready for Christmas."

Prices vary among choose-and-cut Christmas tree farms across the state, but expect to pay anywhere from \$7 to \$10 per foot, which is a marginally higher price than in previous years. Dicke attributes this price increase to trees being taller and growers offering new varieties, such as Mexican cypress and green giant arborvitae. Tree farms also offer more traditional varieties, including Virginia pine, Leyland cypress and Western cypress.

Despite the loss of many young and newly planted trees, there is an uptick in the number of trees ready for harvest, allowing producers to better meet steady demand.

"Our growers can sell almost every tree they grow," Dicke said. "Seventy percent of our growers are now supplementing their farm production with trees from other states to meet customer demand. Supplemental sales also give customers additional varieties of trees to purchase that will not grow in Mississippi."

According to a survey of growers by the Southern Christmas Tree Association, Mississippi's 2015 harvest is projected to exceed 30,000 trees with a total value of \$1.68 million -- about \$56 per tree. The average producer can expect to sell about 960 homegrown trees this year, with an additional 570 trees purchased from other

states to meet customer demand.

While the early fall dry spell stunted the growth of many of his trees by about one foot, Larry Haley, owner of Holly Berry Hills Tree Farm, said he suffered the most damage from the constant rain his fields absorbed in March and April. He manages about 5,300 trees over his 17-acre farm in Saucier.

"This is the first time I've had too wet of a spring," Haley said. "We lost not quite 100 trees due to too much water draining through the soil. When my trees needed rain to flourish after we sheared them, we got really dry. That didn't hurt us as much, but I could have had an extra foot of growth on most of them with proper rain during that time. We were helped by a good bit of rain in late October and early November."

Dicke said the state has about 80 Christmas tree growers, eight of whom are new to the industry and selling trees for the first time this year. Southern Christmas Tree Association survey data indicates the average tree farm is 10 acres and is managed by a family who has been in the business for 22 years and expects to grow and sell Christmas trees for another 13 years.

Cranberry Apple Punch

2 cups apple cider
2 cups ginger ale or ginger beer
2 cups cranberry juice
1 cup frozen cranberries

Combine all ingredients and pour over ice.

Pumpkin Mousse with Nutmeg Caramel

15 ounces pumpkin puree (fresh is best)
1 3/4 cups whole milk, divided
1/2 cup sugar
3 tablespoons cornstarch
1 cup whipping cream
3/4 teaspoon salt, divided
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 cup brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
2 tablespoons butter
1/4 teaspoon salt

Combine pumpkin puree, 1 1/2 cups milk, sugar and cornstarch in a medium saucepan. Stir over medium-low heat until thickened. Remove from heat and cool completely. Whip cream and fold gently with 1/2 teaspoon salt and vanilla into cooled pumpkin mixture. Chill for 2 hours.

In a medium saucepan, stir brown sugar, nutmeg, remaining 1/4 cup milk, butter and 1/4 teaspoon salt over medium heat until bubbly and well combined. Spoon warm caramel sauce over servings of mousse.

Holiday Candy Popcorn

8 cups air-popped popcorn
1 cup water
2 cups sugar
1 cup white corn syrup
1 tablespoon butter
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 cup dried cranberries
3/4 cup white chocolate chips
1/2 cup pistachios, shelled and roasted

Place popcorn in a large mixing bowl. Combine the water, sugar, corn syrup and butter in a heavy saucepan. Cook over moderate heat to 280 degrees (measure with a candy thermometer). Remove from heat and add the vanilla. Stir well and pour over the popped corn. Coat completely. Add the cranberries, chocolate chips and pistachios. Toss again. Cool completely. Break into pieces and store in an airtight container.

Brown Sugar Fudge

2/3 cup evaporated milk
2 cups brown sugar, firmly packed
3/4 cup unsalted butter, cut into chunks
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 3/4 cups powdered sugar
1 cup toasted walnuts, optional

In a heavy medium-sized pot, bring evaporated milk, brown sugar, butter and salt to a boil over medium-high heat, stirring constantly. Reduce heat to low and stir frequently until candy thermometer reads 240 degrees, about 20-30 minutes. Pour mixture into a metal bowl (a plastic bowl will melt) and add vanilla. Beat with electric mixer at medium speed. Add powdered sugar slowly and continue beating until fudge is thick and smooth, about 3-4 minutes. Add walnuts and stir with spoon. Spread in an ungreased 8-inch square pan; refrigerate uncovered for about 30 minutes. Top with toasted walnuts, if desired. Cut into small squares before serving.

Peppermint Hot Chocolate

1/4 cup cocoa powder
1/2 cup sugar
1/4 cup water
4 cups whole milk
1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract
1/4 teaspoon salt
Small peppermint sticks or candy canes for garnish, optional

In a saucepan, combine the cocoa powder, sugar and water. Stir together over low heat until well combined. Pour in milk, peppermint extract and salt. Stir occasionally until well heated. Pour into mugs, and top with whipped cream a short peppermint stick.

Traditional Wassail

1 gallon apple cider
2 cups orange juice
1 cup lemon juice
1/2 cup sugar
2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 teaspoon cloves
1 teaspoon nutmeg
1 orange, sliced

Mix juices, sugar and seasonings together. Slowly bring mixture to a boil in a large saucepan or pot. Boil for one minute. Reduce heat and simmer for 30 minutes. Serve hot with sliced oranges floating in the punch bowl.



Poinsettias and Pickles

When I think of memories and traditions celebrated in my family during the month of December, I think of hunting a Christmas tree in the woods, eating special dishes prepared only this time of year, visiting with family, and sharing stories we seem to tell over and over about things we did as kids. Houses are decorated with red poinsettias, cozy fires burn in our fireplaces, and pickles hang from the tree...wait, what?

The pickle really isn't a family tradition for us, but I do have one in my ornament collection. Momma said it was good luck.

Christmas trees and poinsettias, both Mississippi produced commodities, have special stories that make them symbols of Christmas in our culture. The Christmas tree tradition came to the United States through German immigrants who settled in Pennsylvania around 1830. There are several legends about the origin on this symbol, but all revolve around an evergreen tree that represents everlasting life.

Poinsettias were brought to this country from Mexico by a man called Joel Roberts Poinsett, who was the first ambassador to Mexico. While visiting the Taco area in 1828, he sent some of the plants back to his South Carolina plantation, where he began growing the plants and sending them to friends and botanical gardens. Their botanical name is 'Euphorbia pulcherrima,' which means, 'the most beautiful Euphorbia.'

The shape of the poinsettia flower and leaves are sometimes thought as a symbol of the Star of Bethlehem which led the Wise Men to Jesus.

The red colored leaves symbolize the blood of Christ. The white leaves represent His purity. There is a Mexican legend associated with the plant that also links it to Christmas.

But, what about that pickle? The Christmas pickle is also a tradition in the United States dating back to the late 19th Century. There are a number of different stories about the basis of this custom where a decoration in the shape of a pickle is hidden on a Christmas tree. It is said that the first finder of the pickle would receive an extra present or to have a year of good fortune.

Legends include a story of a Civil War hostage who begged his prison guard for a pickle on Christmas Eve. The guard provided the pickle and he was saved from starvation. Another is a story that involves St. Nicholas saving two Spanish children who were trapped in a barrel of pickles by an innkeeper.

In my opinion, the tradition commonly believed by Americans to have originated in Germany, although completely unknown nor practiced in that country, has a very simple beginning. In the early 20th century Americans decorated their trees mainly with homemade ornaments, apples, nuts and popcorn. In the 1890's glass blown decorative ornaments began to be imported from Germany and France. These ornaments were in the shapes of decorative vegetables, including pickles. So, there you have it. An ornament salesman invented the legend of the Christmas pickle, and it did come from Germany (or maybe France) after all!

Each of you likely have special family traditions you practice during the month of December. We invite you to join us at the Ag Museum



Preventing Livestock Theft

Commissioner Cindy Hyde-Smith and the Mississippi Agriculture & Livestock Theft Bureau of the MDAC would like to remind you to be watchful of livestock theft.

In 2015, the Mississippi Agriculture & Livestock Theft Bureau saw a rise in livestock theft across the state. The majority of cases investigated resulted in arrests, and officers were able to recover livestock. In a few instances, cattle had been shipped to another state.

As always, the Mississippi Agriculture & Livestock Theft Bureau recommends branding of livestock. Ear tags can be easily removed; without branding or tattooing livestock, there is no real way to prove ownership or identity. With livestock theft on the rise, it is recommended to routinely check on livestock as often as possible. Be sure to keep all gates locked, and lock catch pens as well to make it hard or deter criminals from loading livestock.

There has been an increase in arrests in cases where livestock owners do not receive prompt payment when selling cattle. The 2013 legislature amended the livestock theft statute to cover this crime:

(97-17-53) (1) (c) Obtaining livestock from a commission merchant or livestock owner by representing that prompt payment will be made pursuant to Section 409 of the Packers and Stockyards Act, 7 USCS Section 228b, and failing to make prompt payment in accordance therewith, shall constitute prima facie evidence of fraudulent conduct, practices and representation.

The Mississippi Agriculture & Livestock Theft Bureau has investigated numerous complaints in 2015 with some of those investigations

resulting in arrest.

If you are a victim of livestock theft, make sure you contact the Mississippi Agriculture & Livestock Theft Bureau immediately. In addition, contact your neighbors to see if they witnessed anything unusual. The sooner the loss is identified and reported, the more likely it is the animal(s) will be recovered.

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
