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Housing Starts Lift Sawtimber Prices

An increase in housing starts in 2015 strengthened Mississippi's timber industry, and stronger demand for sawtimber products used in construction are helping give the industry a boost this year.

James Henderson, an associate professor of forestry with the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said timber ended the year with a total estimated harvest value of almost \$1.67 billion.

"The markets for sawtimber have shown much improvement over the past couple of years, particularly for

hardwood sawtimber and, to a lesser degree, pine sawtimber," he said.

In 2015, the U.S. Census Bureau reported housing starts increased 10.9 percent from 2014. However, an excess supply of standing pine sawtimber reduced delivered prices for this segment of the industry.

For the first quarter of 2016, Mississippi average stumpage prices for hardwood sawtimber was \$39 per ton. Pine sawtimber stumpage was \$23 per ton. Hardwood pulpwood was priced at \$10 per ton, and pine pulpwood was priced at \$8 per ton.

Henderson said pulpwood markets, particularly in north Mississippi, are limited and have not done as well.

"A new plywood mill opening in Louisville should improve competition for larger diameter timber in northern Mississippi," he said. "Landowners also get another option for timber sales when a new sawmill opens in Newton this year."

Stephen Dicke, MSU Extension forestry specialist, said central Mississippi landowners will continue to experience increased pest pressure and some tree loss following last year's drought and heat.

Extreme drought and an extended fall created ideal conditions for Ips bark beetles and deodar weevils to thrive in central Mississippi's pine stands.

Both pests bore into the inner pine bark to reproduce. Ips beetles carve out distinctive straight tunnels to lay eggs. Deodar weevils make wood-chip cocoons for larvae. These cocoons, which resemble miniature bird nests are easily identified when bark is removed.

"In central Mississippi, we had no significant rainfall between July 4 and Halloween in 2015," Dicke said. "During several of those weeks, we had temperatures between 90 and

100 degrees. Those conditions followed by above-average fall temperatures that extended into December put the whammy on our pine trees."

Dicke said landowners have experienced drought and extended fall temperatures in the past, but the combination of the two is particularly stressful for trees. Ips beetles and deodar weevils usually go dormant in the winter when temperatures drop.

"Trees were already struggling because they had used up all of their reserved energy surviving the lack of rainfall and high temperatures," he said. "When the beetles and weevils attacked in November and December, the trees just didn't have enough defense mechanism left to keep them at bay. As a result of the increased stress, some landowners lost up to 25 percent of their pine timber."

The good news is that beetle counts conducted by the Mississippi Forestry Commission detected high populations of checkered clerid beetles, which are natural enemies of both Ips beetles and southern pine beetles, Dicke said.

However, landowners should scout their timber throughout the summer to check for Ips beetles and deodar weevils, he said.

Ips beetles and southern pine beetles have a similar appearance, but there is one distinct difference. Both are very small -- about the size of a gnat. However, the Ips beetle has a blunt rear end, and the southern pine beetle has a rounded rear end.

"It is important for landowners to be able to recognize the pest they have so they can apply the proper treatment," Dicke said. "Southern pine beetle has a much higher potential to do harm than Ips. Southern pine beetle-infested stands should be treated immediately."

Best Barbecue Side Dishes



Root Beer Baked Beans

3 bacon slices
1 small onion, diced
2 16-ounce cans pork and beans
1/2 cup root beer (not diet)
1/4 cup hickory-smoked barbecue sauce
1/2 teaspoon dry mustard
1/8 teaspoon hot sauce

Cook bacon in a skillet over medium heat until crisp; remove and drain on paper towels, reserving 2 tablespoons drippings in skillet. Crumble bacon. Sauté diced onion in hot bacon drippings in skillet over high heat five minutes or until tender. Stir together onion, crumbled bacon, beans, root beer, barbecue sauce, dry mustard, and hot sauce in a lightly greased one-quart baking dish. Bake beans, uncovered, at 400° for 55 minutes or until sauce is thickened.

Grilled Jalapeno-Lime Corn on the Cob

8 ears fresh corn, husks removed
Vegetable cooking spray
Salt and freshly ground pepper
1/2 cup butter, softened
1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and minced
1 small garlic clove, pressed
1 tablespoon lime zest
1 tablespoon fresh lime juice
2 teaspoons chopped fresh cilantro
Garnish: lime zest

Preheat grill to 350° to 400° (medium-high) heat. Coat corn lightly with cooking spray. Sprinkle with desired amount of salt and pepper. Grill corn, covered with grill lid, 15 minutes or until golden brown, turning occasionally. Meanwhile, stir together butter, jalapeno pepper, garlic, lime zest, lime juice and cilantro. Remove corn from grill, and cut into thirds. Serve corn with butter mixture. Garnish with lime zest, if desired.

Tomato and Onion Salad

1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
1 1/2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon sugar
1/4 teaspoon pepper
4 large tomatoes, thinly sliced
1 medium-sized sweet onion, thinly sliced
1/4 cup chopped fresh basil

Whisk together olive oil, balsamic vinegar, salt, sugar, and pepper in a large bowl. Arrange tomato and onion slices in rows in a serving dish. Sprinkle with chopped basil, and drizzle evenly with marinade. Cover and let stand at room temperature for at least two hours. Serve with slotted spoon.

Barbecue Deviled Eggs

12 large eggs
1/4 cup mayonnaise
1/3 cup finely chopped smoked pork
1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/8 teaspoon hot sauce
Garnish: paprika

Place eggs in a single layer in a large saucepan; add water to a depth of three inches. Bring water to a boil; cover, remove from heat, and let stand 15 minutes. Drain and fill pan with cold water and ice. Tap each egg firmly on the counter until cracks form all over the shell. Peel under cold running water. Cut eggs in half lengthwise and carefully remove yolks. Mash yolks with mayonnaise. Stir in pork, Dijon mustard, salt, pepper, and hot sauce; blend well. Spoon yolk mixture evenly into egg white halves; garnish with paprika, if desired.

Napa Cabbage-and-Sweet Pepper Slaw

1 cup rice vinegar
1/4 cup honey
2 1/4 teaspoons kosher salt
4 cups chopped Napa cabbage
1 cup seeded and thinly sliced sweet mini peppers
1/4 large red onion, thinly sliced
1/4 cup firmly packed fresh flat-leaf parsley leaves
2 tablespoons chopped fresh mint

Stir together rice vinegar, honey, salt and one cup water in a small saucepan. Bring mixture to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat to medium, and simmer five minutes; remove from heat. Toss together cabbage, peppers, onion, parsley, and mint in a medium bowl. Transfer to a jar; add vinegar mixture, and screw on lid. Chill 8 to 12 hours, turning occasionally. Store slaw in refrigerator up to three days.

Candied Jalapenos

1 12-ounce jar pickled jalapeno pepper slices
4 red chile peppers, sliced
3/4 cup sugar
1 teaspoon loosely packed lime zest

Drain pickled jalapeno pepper slices, discarding liquid and reserving jar and lid. Toss together jalapeno slices, red chile pepper slices, sugar and lime zest. Let stand five minutes, stirring occasionally. Spoon mixture into reserved jar, scraping any remaining sugar mixture from bowl into jar. Cover with lid, and chill 48 hours to one week, shaking jar several times a day to dissolve any sugar that settles.







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State's Produce Offers New Value to Gleaners

An organization ready to harvest and distribute quality food to the hungry always looks for new farms to glean and more hands to help with the work.

The Mississippi Gleaning Network exists to link agricultural endeavors with organizations that distribute food to the needy. It is operated under the Society of St. Andrew, a Christian nonprofit, nationwide organization that supplies the volunteer labor.

Gleaning is an ancient practice in which workers are allowed into a harvested field to gather for themselves the food that is left over.

"We glean the fields to prevent waste and feed America's hungry," said Andy Lemmon, program coordinator for the Mississippi Gleaning Network. "Last year in Mississippi, we salvaged 1.9 million pounds of food and gave it to charitable organizations that donate it to the hungry."

A typical example of gleaning came in early June when a grower opened a blackberry field in Tupelo for gleaners.

"We had a producer invite us in to glean his fields, and our volunteers picked 170 pounds of blackberries in one day," he said. "The pickers came from Columbus and West Point and took some back to organizations in their area that could distribute the berries that day. I took several pounds back to Jackson and gave them to men's homes and nursing homes that are feeding between 20

and 50 people a day."

The Mississippi State University Extension Service has helped link Mississippi farmers with gleaners.

Rick Snyder, Extension vegetable specialist at the MSU Truck Crops Branch Experiment Station in Crystal Springs, said the whole concept of gleaning is mutually beneficial to the producer and Mississippians who have limited access to fresh produce because of geography or income.

"Mississippi has a pretty serious problem with food deserts in parts of the state that don't have access to fresh, healthy produce. The gleaning network can get fresh farm products into the hands and onto the tables of people who really need it," Snyder said.

"On the farmers' side, there's always waste in agriculture because you can't harvest everything in your field. There's always something left over," he said. "If the farmer allows in gleaners, they will harvest much of the remaining crop and put it to really good use for the people of Mississippi."

In addition to preventing waste and making fresh food available for free to those who need it, there's a tax benefit available to producers who allow their fields to be gleaned.

"Gleaning results in a charitable donation based on the pounds harvested from their field, and that can help producers reduce their tax bills," Snyder said.

MSU has been involved in several gleaning opportunities through the years. Service D.A.W.G.S. participants have bagged up gleaned sweet potatoes, preparing them for distribution. The Truck Crops Experiment

Station has in the past opened the gates of its 3-acre garden to gleaners to harvest produce that remained.

Lemmon said gleaning efforts require a source of food that can be harvested for free, volunteers able to respond very quickly when a field can be harvested, a staging area for delivery and organizations in place that can distribute the food quickly.

"In Mississippi, we typically have specialty crops available for gleaning, which means any kind of produce," he said. "Food available for gleaning includes perfectly edible items that are just not marketable because of cosmetic issues.

"A zucchini may be too big to sell but perfectly good to eat. We had a whole truckload of bananas once that had been riding too long and had to be unloaded and distributed quickly," Lemmon said. "We keep food that is perfectly edible from going to waste."

Gleaning and food distribution requires more than just volunteers picking produce in the field. Lemmon said one church group cut and tied hundreds of red mesh produce bags so he could have them on hand when needed.

"We will find something for you to do if you want to get involved," he said. "Just contact us now so we know who you are and can link the job with the people who can do it."
