The Mississippi Agriculture & Forestry Museum on Lakeland Drive will host the annual Harvest Days and Festival on November 11-14, 2009. Small Town Mississippi comes to life with demonstrations on the weekdays from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm and on Saturday from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm. Demonstrations include the operation of the cotton gin, saw mill, cane mill, grist mill, blacksmith shop and print shop. Free biscuits will be given away to all attendees.

On November 11, 12 and 13, Watershed Harmony, an educational puppet show about water quality will be available. Train and hay rides are available each day from 9:00 am-4:00 pm for \$ 1 per rider.

Admission is as follows: Adults: \$5, Senior Adults (ages 60 and over): \$4, Children ages 5-18: \$3 and Children ages 3-4: \$1.
