MDAC's Bureau of Plant Industry Revokes Termite License of Wilson's Termite and Environmental Services

The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce has terminated, effective immediately, the professional services license of James Wilson, owner of Wilson's Termite and Environmental Services of Brandon, Mississippi, for violating state standards relating to termite treatments. This regulatory action will also prohibit the offender from serving in any other capacity for other pest control businesses offering termite services in the State of Mississippi.

The investigation began after inspections revealed that Wilson's Termite and Environmental Services failed to perform pesticide treatments according to regulation, potentially leaving properties vulnerable to termite infestation. This discovery, along with complaints from concerned homeowners and employees, led to the decision to cancel Wilson's license.

The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce administers the regulation and licensing of pest control operators through the Bureau of Plant Industry to protect the citizens of Mississippi from fraudulent practices and improper pesticide applications.
