All pilots are required to be licensed by the Department, and in order to renew a license the pilot must make application to the Department and:

1. Demonstrate competency by passing a written examination administered by the Department; or submit proof of competency from another state. (Pilots who have taken and passed the certification examination in Mississippi can meet the requirement by attending an approved training session). Indicate the method you plan to use to meet the requirement by checking the proper block in Section B of the application.
2. Hold a current commercial pilot certificate from FAA, with current medical and rating for type of aircraft.

All licenses will expire on the 31st of March of the year following their issuance or renewal.
