Consider These 10 Garden Resolutions for 2015

The brand-new year is the perfect time to make gardening resolutions.

My job at Mississippi State University's Coastal Research and Extension Center in Biloxi gives me the opportunity to answer a lot of questions and solve many garden problems. Based on this experience, here's my list of resolutions Mississippi gardeners can make to be more successful in the new year.



1) **Planting:** Competitive gardeners -- and this includes me -- want to have the first tomato in the neighborhood. This usually means putting transplants out in the garden a full month before the last frost date. Don't do it. Plant according to the frost dates for your area. You may not have the first tomato, but you won't have to replant, either.

2) **Starting:** Transplants are thought to be expensive, so many gardeners start their own seeds. This can result in disappointment and no transplants. Seedlings get leggy when grown inside without sufficient light. Unless you use grow lights, buy transplants from your favorite garden center.

3) **Rotating:** Every year, I get calls from gardeners asking why their tomatoes looked good one day and the next they have wilted to nothing. Mississippi has a high incidence of bacterial wilts that result from planting in the same spots year after year. Grow your tomatoes in a new spot in the garden each year to help this

situation.

4) **Discarding:** This idea is for those gardeners who grow their own seedlings and often have extras. We don't have the heart to just throw them away, so we end up planting them. This results in more work on hot summer days and takes a lot of the fun out of the garden. Consider making new friends by giving the extras

to your neighbors.

5) **Weeding:** Weeds compete with garden plants for light, water, and fertilizer. Once established, they are a lot of work to remove. Try to weed your garden on a regular basis. I like using a hula hoe to easily remove small weed seedlings.

6) **Feeding:** You have to fertilize your plants to have a good harvest. Get your soil tested and follow the recommendations. You will not be sorry.

7) **Watering:** You can't rely on Mother Nature to supply enough water for your garden. Get in the habit of watering on a daily basis, preferably in the morning. If you don't want to stand out there with a hose, there are inexpensive irrigation kits available at home improvement centers.

8) **Preserving:** Enjoying fresh vegetables is a gardener's dream, but there are times when the harvest is just too much. Extend the harvest into the cold win-

ter months by preserving your bounty. The MSU Extension Service offers advice on how to do so safely.

9) **Sharing:** If you don't want to preserve your bountiful harvest, take the excess to your local soup kitchen or food pantry to share with the less fortunate. You may be able to make a little money by selling the extras at a local farmers' market. Either way, always call ahead to see if there are any restrictions on what you can offer.

10) **Recycling:** Build a compost pile and always put used plant material and other organic wastes on the pile. Next year, add this black gold to your garden and start the cycle all over again.

If you follow these resolutions I can almost -- notice I said almost -- guarantee you'll have more fun in the garden this year.

New Year Good Luck Recipes



Skillet Cornbread

2 to 3 teaspoons bacon drippings or vegetable oil
2 cups buttermilk
1 large egg
1 3/4 cups white cornmeal
1 teaspoon baking powder
1 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon salt
Butter

Coat bottom and sides of a 10-inch cast-iron skillet with bacon drippings; heat in a 450° oven for 10 minutes. Whisk together buttermilk and egg. Add cornmeal, stirring well. Stir in baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Pour batter into hot skillet. Bake at 450° for 15 minutes. Serve with butter.

Southern-Style Collard Greens

12 hickory-smoked bacon slices, finely chopped
2 medium-size sweet onion, finely chopped
3/4 pound smoked ham, chopped
6 garlic cloves, finely chopped
3 32-ounce containers chicken broth
3 1-pound packages fresh collard greens, washed & trimmed
1/3 cup apple cider vinegar
1 tablespoon sugar
1 teaspoon salt
3/4 teaspoon pepper

Cook bacon in a 10-quart stockpot over medium heat for 10 to 12 minutes, or until it is almost crisp. Add onion and sauté 8 minutes; add ham and garlic, and sauté one minute. Stir in broth and remaining ingredients. Cook two hours or to desired degree of tenderness.

Good Luck Greens & Peas with Ham

1 32-ounce container vegetable broth
1 16-ounce package frozen black-eyed peas, thawed
1 sweet onion, cut into eighths
1 cup apple cider vinegar
1/4 teaspoon dried crushed red pepper
2 tablespoons dark brown sugar
2 tablespoons country-style Dijon mustard
1 5-to-6-pound smoked, fully cooked semi-boneless ham
1 1-pound package shredded fresh collard greens

Place vegetable broth, black-eyed peas, onion, apple cider vinegar, and red pepper in a 6-quart slow cooker. Stir together brown sugar and mustard; rub mixture over ham. Place ham in slow cooker. Cover and cook on HIGH 6 to 7 hours or until ham is tender. Uncover and add collard greens. Cover and cook on HIGH 1 hour or until tender. Slice ham, and serve with greens mixture.

Chili-Roasted Black Eyed Peas

2 15.8-ounce cans black-eyed peas, rinsed & drained
3 tablespoons olive oil
1 1/2 teaspoons chili powder
1 teaspoon pepper
3/4 teaspoon ground cumin
1/2 teaspoon salt

Preheat oven to 425°. Combine all ingredients in a medium bowl. Transfer mixture to a lightly greased 17 x 12-inch jelly roll pan. Bake 45 to 50 minutes or until crispy and dry, stirring every 10 minutes. Let cool 20 minutes.

Hoppin' John

1 cup diced sweet onion
2 tablespoons bacon drippings
1 8.5-ounce package ready-to-serve jasmine rice
2 cups cooked & drained black-eyed peas
Salt & pepper to taste

Sauté diced onion in bacon drippings in a large skillet over medium-high heat for 5 minutes or until golden. Stir in rice and black-eyed peas; cook, stirring gently, 5 minutes or until thoroughly heated. Add salt and pepper to taste.

Hot Cider Nog

2 cups half-and-half
1 cup milk
1 cup apple cider
2 large eggs
1/2 cup sugar
1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/8 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg
Sweetened whipped cream
Cinnamon sticks
Ground cinnamon
Apple slices

Whisk together the first 8 ingredients in a heavy saucepan. Cook mixture over medium-low heat, whisking constantly for 15 to 20 minutes, or until mixture thickens and coats a spoon. Remove from heat and pour into 5 cups or mugs, and top with sweetened whipped cream. Garnish with cinnamon sticks, ground cinnamon, and apple slices, if desired.



USDA Seeks Public Comment on New EQIP Rule

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is publishing a rule that outlines how it will improve the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP), one of USDA's largest conservation programs. The interim final rule includes program changes authorized by Congress in the 2014 Farm Bill.

USDA has established a 60-day comment period for the rule. The rule is available in the Federal Register and regulations.gov. Public comments can be submitted through regulations.gov or by mailing them. Comments are due by February 10, 2015. Full details are in the Federal Register notice.

"This interim final rule provides a roadmap to help streamline and simplify EQIP for farmers and ranchers," Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack said. "We strongly encourage agricultural producers, private forest landowners, and stakeholders to provide comments on our implementation processes. This feedback will help us improve our operation and deliver technical and financial assistance more efficiently to our nation's agricultural producers and forest landowners."

The changes are intended to simplify the EQIP regulation regarding conservation practice scheduling, payment limitations, and other administrative actions. Vilsack said USDA has enhanced EQIP by streamlining the delivery of technical and financial assistance to agricultural producers and forest landowners nationwide.

Highlights of program changes in this rule include the following:

- Requires at least 5 percent of available EQIP funds be targeted for conservation practices that promote wildlife habitat;
- Establishes EQIP as a contributing program for the Regional Conservation Partnership Program;
- Increases the advanced payment from 30 percent to 50 percent for eligible historically underserved producers, including beginning farmers, to help purchase material or contract services;
- Targets assistance to veteran farmers and ranchers including eligibility for the new 50 percent advance payment and up to 90 percent of the cost to implement EQIP conservation practices;
- Increases the payment limita-

tion for EQIP from \$300,000 to a maximum of \$450,000 for benefits received during 2014-2018 and removes the option for a waiver to exceed payment limitations;

- Eliminates the requirement for a program contract to remain in place for one year after the last practice has been implemented, allowing practices to be scheduled through the tenth year of a contract;
- Includes an option to waive the irrigation history requirement under certain conditions;
- Incorporates the Wildlife Habitat Incentive Program functions into EQIP.

This rule follows the publication of the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) interim final rule in the Federal Register on November 5, 2014. USDA is also seeking comments for the CSP rule.

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) administers EQIP, a voluntary program that provides financial and technical assistance to eligible agricultural producers and forest landowners to help them address soil, water, air, and related natural resource concerns on their lands in an environmentally beneficial and cost-effective manner. Resulting conservation and environmental benefits include improved water and air quality, reduced soil erosion and sedimentation, improved energy conservation, improved grazing and forest lands, and created or improved wildlife habitat on working farms, ranches, and non-industrial forestlands.

EQIP has touched the lives of hundreds of thousands of agricultural producers and forest landowners since its launch in 1997. From that time through 2014, USDA has invested in 596,481 contracts for a total of nearly \$11 billion on nearly 232 million acres nationwide.
