Average Yield Expected for 2015 Pecan Crop

Despite a wet spring followed by a dry summer and fall, Mississippi should have average pecan yields in 2015.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture forecasts the state will produce 1.3 million pounds of pecans in 2015, which is up 30 percent from the 1 million pounds produced in 2014.

"A very rainy spring led to disease issues, but a dry summer was bad for nut filling," said Eric Stafne, associate Extension and research professor with Mississippi State University. "Dry conditions on unirrigated orchards have led to some poorly

filled, unmarketable nuts and significant leaf drop."

Growers struggled to control pecan scab, which is worsened by wet weather.

"This disease is prevalent in unmanaged orchards, and the heavy rains in the spring led to great conditions for it to proliferate this year," Stafne said.

Several insects can infest pecan orchards, including beetles, aphids and microscopic insects that cause pecan phylloxera.

"Phylloxera is prevalent every year, but by the time growers see it, the damage is done, and it is too late to do anything about it," Stafne said. "Other insects, like stink bugs and pecan weevils, can be problematic in certain orchards."

Aphids plagued central and south Mississippi growers who got very little rain in the fall.

"We had a lot of aphids this year," said Max Draughn, owner of Pecan Hill Farms and Bass Pecan Company in Raymond. "Usually the rain helps wash some of them away, but this fall we've been so dry."

Lane Varner, nursery manager at Pecan Hill Farms, said the farm also had a few types of beetles and some problems with phylloxera.

"We sprayed a few times for the insects we had, and everything was fine," Varner said. "The phylloxera wasn't widespread."

Lack of rain has delayed harvest, said Draughn, who is also president of the Mississippi Pecan Growers Association.

"In the last few weeks of development, pecans need between a half inch and an inch of water for the nuts to fully mature and the green outer shell to open and release the nuts," he said on October 8. "If we'd had adequate rain this summer, we'd already be harvesting."

Draughn irrigates some of his highly managed blocks of trees with

pond water, but that source dried up a few weeks before the first round of harvest began during the second week of October.

Growers across the state will begin harvest later than usual, and yield will vary depending on the amount of rain their orchards received this summer.

"North Mississippi will have a good crop. Central Mississippi will have a so-so crop. And south Mississippi will have no crop," Draughn said.

Early-season wholesale prices for good-quality, improved varieties of in-shell pecans are between \$2.50 and \$3 per pound. These pecans are selling at retail outlets for between \$4.50 and \$5.50.

Shelled mammoth pecan halves will wholesale for about \$9 per pound and retail for about \$13 per pound, Draughn said.

Mississippi Pecan History

Pecans are well adapted and widely grown throughout Mississippi. Where the proper varieties have been chosen, good success can be expected near the Gulf Coast and the Delta, but other areas of the state can support pecan production, as well.

Historically, numerous varieties originated in Jackson County, many of which have no commercial viability today. In the 1920s and 1930s, the five most prominent varieties in the southeast were Alley, Pabst, Schley, Success and Stuart, all originating in Jackson County. Of the historical

varieties, only Stuart, Schley, Success and Desirable continue to be of commercial importance today.

Nearly 75 percent of pecan production in Mississippi is from improved variety trees. The remaining trees are native or seedling; some of these are in orchards and some in natural groves along the river bottoms in the Delta area. Several hurricanes, including Camille and Katrina, devastated pecan orchards in the six counties near the Gulf of Mexico. Many orchards were entirely destroyed and others severely damaged.

In general, Mississippi growers produce, harvest and market two million to four million pounds of

pecans per year, including improved varieties and natives, from more than 14,000 acres. In the 1930s, production ranged between five million and six million pounds annually. During the 1960s, the average annual production of pecans ranged from 15 million to 20 million pounds, with the largest harvest during that decade coming in at 30 million pounds. As a state, average yields may be as low as 200 pounds per acre, but intensive and standard orchards in a good year can produce 1,000 pounds or more per acre.

Maple Bacon Pecan Brittle

1 cup white sugar
1/2 cup water
6 tablespoons light corn syrup
2 tablespoons maple syrup
1 cup pecans
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
3/4 cup crumbled, cooked maple bacon
1 teaspoon baking soda

Bring sugar, water, corn syrup and maple syrup to a boil in a large skillet over medium-high heat, stirring constantly. Heat to 250 degrees F or until a small amount of syrup dropped into cold water forms a rigid ball. Stir pecans and vanilla into syrup mixture until mixture begins to turn brown; add bacon. Cook until bacon mixture turns light brown, 1 to 3 minutes. Remove from heat and stir baking soda into bacon mixture. Pour brittle out onto a sheet of parchment paper set on a heat-proof surface and cool brittle to room temperature before breaking into pieces, at least 30 minutes.

Toasted Pecan Butter

1/2 cup chopped pecans
1/4 cup light brown sugar
1 cup butter at room temperature
1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Spread the pecans onto a baking sheet; toast in the preheated oven until they start to turn golden brown and become fragrant, about 15 minutes. Watch carefully as they bake, as they tend to burn quickly. Set aside to cool to room temperature. Pulse the brown sugar, butter, and vanilla together in a food processor several times to thoroughly combine. Butter will be slightly fluffy. Sprinkle in the cooled nuts and pulse several times to combine. For more finely ground pecans, pulse several more times. Serve immediately or pack into a jar with a lid and refrigerate. Note: this makes a great condiment at holiday brunches. Serve with toast, French toast, rolls, biscuits, pancakes, etc.

Roasted Brussels Sprouts with Pecans

2 pounds Brussels sprouts, trimmed and halved lengthwise
1 cup coarsely chopped pecans
2 tablespoons olive oil
2 cloves garlic, finely chopped
Kosher salt and ground black pepper

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Place the Brussels sprouts, pecans, olive oil, and garlic onto a large rimmed baking sheet, and toss the ingredients together until well combined and coated with oil. Spread out into a single layer, and turn the Brussels sprouts to face cut sides down. Roast in the preheated oven until golden brown and tender, 20 to 25 minutes.

Sweet Potato Pecan Waffles

1 cup canned sweet potato puree
3 egg yolks
1 cup milk
1 1/2 cups cake flour
1 tablespoon baking powder
1 tablespoon white sugar
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1/4 cup chopped pecans
3 egg whites
3 tablespoons butter, melted
2 tablespoons pecans, chopped

Stir together flour, baking powder, sugar, salt, nutmeg and 1/4 cup pecans. Mix sweet potato puree, egg yolks and milk in a large bowl until well combined. Add flour mixture, and mix well. Beat egg whites until stiff peaks form. Fold 1/4 of the egg whites into batter. Lightly fold remaining whites and melted butter into the batter. Cook in a hot waffle iron. Garnish with more chopped pecans.

Sugar Coated Pecans

1 egg white
1 tablespoon water
1 pound pecan halves
1 cup white sugar
3/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Preheat oven to 250 degrees F. Grease one baking sheet. In a mixing bowl, whip together the egg white and water until frothy. In a separate bowl, mix together sugar, salt and cinnamon. Add pecans to egg whites; stir to coat the nuts evenly. Remove the nuts, and toss them in the sugar mixture until coated. Spread the nuts out on the prepared baking sheet. Bake for one hour, stirring every 15 minutes.



Mississippi Promotes Agriculture at the Sunbelt Ag Expo

From live blues music to shrimp and catfish, visitors to the Sunbelt Ag Expo in Moultrie, Ga., got quite a taste of Mississippi at the 38th annual event.

Each year, one of the participating Southeastern states serves as a spotlight state and has the opportunity to put its unique accomplishments and commodities on display.

Gary Jackson, director of the Mississippi State University Extension Service, said key organizations worked together to provide the extensive effort required to create a fun and educational experience for expo participants.

"We appreciate the opportunity given to us by the Sunbelt Ag Expo to tell people about the many aspects of Mississippi's No. 1 industry, agriculture," Jackson said.

Fellow hosts including: Mississippi State University, Alcorn State University, Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation, Mississippi Sweet Potato Council and MSU Coastal Research and Extension Center -- were instrumental in coordinating displays, cooking and serving delicious food, and providing staff to meet and greet the thousands of visitors who toured the spotlight state building," said Jackson.

Agriculture is a \$7.7-billion-a-year (farm-gate value) contribu-

tor to Mississippi's economy. It's estimated the sector brings \$16.7 billion in value-added dollars to the state each year. Mississippi ranks in the top 20 in the production of 15 agricultural commodities ranging from catfish to watermelons.

Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce Cindy Hyde-Smith said she was thrilled to join Mississippi's celebration as the Spotlight State at this year's Sunbelt Ag Expo.

"As Mississippians, we are extremely proud of our state, and this opportunity allows us to showcase our robust agriculture industry. Agriculture is important to all of the participating states, and, though many of the states have similar agricultural landscapes, being the spotlighted state allows us to really show the uniqueness and excellence of Mississippi agriculture," said Hyde-Smith.

600 acre research farm's field demonstrations as farmers watch tractors, combines, peanut pickers, cotton pickers, hay equipment and Global Positioning Systems working side by side. Over 300 seminars were taught at exhibits on beef, dairy, backyard gardening, poultry, forestry, pond management, equine, dairy and cattle management.

A highlight of the 3-day show is the announcement of the Swisher Sweet/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year Award as 10 state winners vie for the prestigious title.

Allen Eubanks was named 2015 Mississippi Farmer of the Year. He is a fourth-generation grower from Lucedale, Miss., who specializes in handpicked vegetable crops. He owns three major enterprises: Eubanks Produce, the main vegetable-farming business; Charlie's U-Pik, a pick-your-own venture; and Farm Fresh Gourmet, a startup company specializing in creative recipes and value-added canning and preserving.

Encompassing about 2,800 acres, Eubanks Produce is one of the largest vegetable farms in Mississippi. Last year, he grew 136 acres of cantaloupes, 850 acres of watermelons, 150 acres of bell peppers, 92 acres of tomatoes, 100 acres of cucumbers, 120 acres of squash, 240 acres of sweet corn and 600 acres of soybeans. This year, he planted his first sweet potatoes on 175 acres.


