Dry Late-Season Weather Delays Pecan Harvest

Despite timely rains throughout the summer, late-season drought is pushing back pecan harvest for most Mississippi producers.

"We thought we were going to be early with our harvest this year when our nuts set early this spring," said Max Draughn, owner of Bass Pecan Company in Raymond and president of the Mississippi Pecan Growers Association. "We had rains every week up until Labor Day. Then we had no rain. We went into slow motion when it got dry."

Draughn began harvest on October 12 for the Creek pecan variety, although green shucks were not at the ideal stage of 50 percent open.

On average, harvest begins around October 8 for Creek. Depending on variety and weather conditions, pecan harvest can begin anytime from late September to mid-October.

"You need rain and several nights of cool temperatures for the shucks to open enough to drop the pecans," Draughn said. "If the harvest goes late and you get a freeze before the shucks open, those pecans will never come off. You just lose them. So, we went ahead and began harvest. Most of the shucks will come off when we run them through the cleaner."

Draughn said Mississippi producers expect the best yield since 2003, when the crop produced about 4 million pounds of pecans.

Average yield for Mississippi producers is about 2 million pounds per year, said Eric Stafne, associate Extension and research professor with Mississippi State University.

"We could see somewhere between 3 million and 4 million pounds this year," he said. "In central and north Mississippi, yield will likely be pretty

good. But in south Mississippi, it will be hit and miss. Overall, it will definitely be better than last year, which was around 1 million pounds."

Pecan scab was an issue for some

growers who had a lot of rain in the spring and summer, but producers have had minimal insect and disease problems overall, Stafne said.

Draughn said he expects pecan

prices to be good throughout the season despite the anticipated high yield.

"We had a smaller than average yield last year, and we don't have any pecans in cold storage," he said. "One-third of U.S.-produced pecans are exported to China by November 15. Pecans are also in high demand by candy companies and shellers during this time, which is also putting pressure on the market."

Early-season farm gate wholesale prices for good-quality, improved varieties of in-shell pecans are between \$2.25 and \$2.50 per pound. Wholesale prices for seedling pecans are between \$1 and \$1.60 per pound.

Quality, shelled mammoth pecan halves will wholesale for between \$8 and \$9 per pound and retail for between \$12 and \$14 per pound, Draughn said.

Mississippi Pecan History

Pecans are well adapted and widely grown throughout Mississippi. Where the proper varieties have been chosen, good success can be expected near the Gulf Coast and the Delta, but other areas of the state can support pecan production, as well.

Historically, numerous varieties originated in Jackson County, many of which have no commercial viability today. In the 1920s and 1930s, the five most prominent varieties in the southeast were Alley, Pabst, Schley, Success and Stuart, all originating in Jackson County. Of the historical

varieties, only Stuart, Schley, Success and Desirable continue to be of commercial importance today.

Nearly 75 percent of pecan production in Mississippi is from improved variety trees. The remaining trees are native or seedling; some of these are in orchards and some in natural groves along the river bottoms in the Delta area. Several hurricanes, including Camille and Katrina, devastated pecan orchards in the six counties near the Gulf of Mexico. Many orchards were entirely destroyed and others severely damaged.

In general, Mississippi growers produce, harvest and market two million to four million pounds of

pecans per year, including improved varieties and natives, from more than 14,000 acres. In the 1930s, production ranged between five million and six million pounds annually. During the 1960s, the average annual production of pecans ranged from 15 million to 20 million pounds, with the largest harvest during that decade coming in at 30 million pounds. As a state, average yields may be as low as 200 pounds per acre, but intensive and standard orchards in a good year can produce 1,000 pounds or more per acre.

Orange Glazed Pecans

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon white corn syrup
- 1/4 cup evaporated milk
- 2 teaspoons orange rind, grated
- 2 tablespoons orange juice
- 2 1/2 cups pecan halves

Mix all ingredients except pecans, and bring to a boil in iron skillet. Boil for four minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and add pecans, coating them well with mixture. Cook one minute. Pour onto waxed paper and let cool. Separate into pieces. These sweet nuts are perfect to give as a holiday food gift!

Hearty Oatmeal with Pears, Raisins and Pecans

- 1 Bosc pear, cored and chopped
- 1 cup old-fashioned oatmeal
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 4 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1/4 cup raisins
- 2 cups water
- 1/4 cup toasted pecans

In a large glass bowl, combine pear, oatmeal, cinnamon, brown sugar, raisins and water. Microwave on high for seven minutes or until pears are tender. Divide between two bowls, top with pecans and enjoy! A satisfying breakfast dish, perfect for a cool fall morning.

Honey-Pecan Chicken Piccata

- 6 split chicken breasts
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1 egg, beaten
- 4 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 1 cup fine breadcrumbs
- 1/2 cup pecans, finely chopped
- 1/2 cup parsley, finely chopped

With a mallet, pound each chicken breast until very flat; set aside. In a bowl, whisk together honey, egg, two tablespoons olive oil, salt, pepper and onion powder. In a separate bowl, combine breadcrumbs and pecans. Heat remaining two tablespoons olive oil in a heavy skillet over medium-high heat. Dip each chicken breast in the honey mixture, coating both sides. Repeat this process in the breadcrumb mixture, coating evenly. Fry chicken in the hot skillet until no longer pink, about five to seven minutes on each side. Serve hot with parsley on top.

Honey Pecan Baby Back Ribs

- 4 pounds baby back pork ribs, cut into 4-5 racks
- 2/3 cup honey, divided
- 1 tablespoon black pepper
- 1 tablespoon paprika
- 1 tablespoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 cup pecans, toasted and finely ground
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 1/4 cups barbecue sauce
- Pecans, chopped and toasted for garnish

Lay each rack of ribs on a large piece of foil. In a small bowl, combine 1/3 cup honey, pepper, paprika, salt and garlic powder. Rub both sides of each rack with one tablespoon of mixture. Wrap foil around ribs and fold to seal. Place foil packets seam-side up on grill over medium heat (300°). Cover and grill for 1 1/2 hours. Remove ribs from grill. Spray grill rack with nonstick cooking spray, and fire up the grill to medium high. In a small bowl, combine ground pecans and flour. Remove ribs from foil, and press pecan mixture into the meaty side of each rack. Combine barbecue sauce and remaining honey; drizzle over pecan crust to cover. Grill ribs over medium heat two-three minutes, starting with the bare side and brushing on sauce as desired. Turn and baste the ribs until they are caramelized. Remove ribs from grill. Before serving, sprinkle with additional pecans and remaining honey barbecue sauce.

Apple Pecan Cherry Salad

- 6 heaping cups apples, chopped (cut into 1/2-inch chunks from 4 to 5 apples)
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1 1/4 cups dried tart cherries
- 1 cup celery, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup red onion, finely chopped
- 1/2 cup light, reduced-fat mayonnaise
- 1 cup pecans, toasted and coarsely chopped

To toast the pecans, place chopped nuts in a single layer on a large-rimmed baking sheet. Place on middle rack in a 350° oven for 10-15 minutes, stirring once during cooking time. Meanwhile, in a large bowl toss chopped apples with lemon zest and juice. Stir in cherries, celery and red onion. Lightly mix in mayonnaise. If serving immediately, stir in toasted pecans. Otherwise, refrigerate and stir in pecans right before serving. Crisp, sweet apples work best in salads. Toasting pecans enhances their natural flavors.







USDA Designates Counties As Disaster Areas

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has designated Attala, Calhoun, Holmes, Kemper, Lauderdale, Montgomery and Webster counties in Mississippi as a primary natural disaster area due to a recent drought.

“Our hearts go out to those Mississippi farmers and ranchers affected by recent natural disasters,” said Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack. “President Obama and I are committed to ensuring that agriculture remains a bright spot in our nation’s economy by sustaining the successes of America’s farmers, ranchers, and rural communities through these difficult times. We’re also telling Mississippi producers that USDA stands with you and your communities when severe weather and natural disasters threaten to disrupt your livelihood.”

Farmers and ranchers in the following counties in Mississippi also qualify for natural disaster assistance because their counties are contiguous. Those counties are: Carroll, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Clarke, Clay, Grenada, Humphreys, Jasper, Lafayette, Leake, Leflore, Madison, Neshoba, Newton, Noxubee, Oktibeha, Pontotoc, Winston, Yalobusha, Yazoo.

All counties listed above were

designated natural disaster areas on October 26, 2016, making all qualified farm operators in the designated areas eligible for low interest emergency (EM) loans from USDA’s Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible counties have eight months from the date of the declaration to apply for loans to help cover part of their actual losses. FSA will consider each loan application on its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability. FSA has a variety of programs, in addition to the EM loan program, to help eligible farmers recover from adversity.

Other FSA programs that can provide assistance, but do not require a disaster declaration, include the Emergency Conservation Program; Livestock Forage Disaster Program; Livestock Indemnity Program; Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees, and Farm-Raised Fish Program; and the Tree Assistance Program. Interested farmers may contact their local USDA Service Centers for further information on eligibility requirements and application procedures for these and other programs. 

MALTB Needs Help Locating Stolen Livestock

The Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau (MALTB), the law enforcement division of the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce, is asking for the public's help locating livestock and medical supplies recently reported as stolen. The thefts occurred in Simpson and Hinds Counties.

A black baldy heifer weighing approximately 650 pounds was stolen from the Simpson County area. The cow has a "BR" brand located on the left hip as shown in Picture A. The heifer was stolen along with a case containing six bottles of Draxxin, an injectable antibiotic solution for cattle.


A two- to three-year-old Black Angus bull was stolen from Hinds County. It weighs between 1,000 and 1,200 pounds and is branded on its left hip with the "L lightning" brand as shown in Picture B.

State's Hay Directory Helps Drought-Affected Producers

Adequate forage for livestock is becoming a concern for Mississippi producers as drought conditions persist, but alternative hay sources and feeding options can compensate for shortages.

The Mississippi Hay Directory helps livestock producers locate hay supplies. The directory is updated each time a new entry is submitted, and listings expire after 60 days.

Mississippi State University Extension Service forage specialist Rocky Lemus said the lack of forage production due to dry conditions has forced producers to begin feeding hay to livestock earlier than normal. Forage shortages are expected in Mississippi and in adjacent states suffering from the drought.

Hay harvested during drought conditions may not contain enough nutrients. Producers can have their hay tested for quality at the Mississippi State Chemical Laboratory.

"Producers need to start putting in place a hay inventory plan that could help them determine the amount of hay needed. If buying hay, make sure the hay being




purchased is at least analyzed for quality parameters," Lemus said. "Many of our grasses are weakened by drought caused by the lack of growth and level of stored sugars in the root system. Under dry conditions, it is important not to graze pasture too short and allow the plants to store sugars to survive the winter."
