**ANNUAL FERTILIZER REGISTRATION INSTRUCTION SHEET
FOR ALL BRANDS AND GRADES OF FERTILIZER**

- The Mississippi Commercial Fertilizer Law of 1970 requires the registration of all fertilizer products and the payment of registration fees for each brand by July 1 of each year. A “STOP SALE” will be placed on all non-registered products found in Mississippi.

- **Registration Procedure**

The online registration system allows you to apply for permits, register products, upload labels, activate and inactivate products, print permits, pay fees, etc. We encourage you to use this system for all your fertilizer permit and product needs. Forms not supplied by MDAC will not be accepted and will be returned to you along with your payment.

Follow instructions printed on each form.

- **Registration Fee Schedule**

A. Fertilizer: There is no fee for permit registration, only for products:

1. \$50 for each grade or brand sold in packaging weighing less than 10lbs
2. \$10 per grade for each product sold in packaging of 10lbs or greater
3. \$50 for products sold in both weight categories.

B. Custom Mix: Permit fees are based on total tons sold during the previous registration year.

Less than 500	\$50
501 – 1,000	\$75
1,001 – 1,500	\$100
1,501 – 2,500	\$150
2,501 – 3,500	\$200
3,501 – 5,000	\$250
Over 5,000	\$300

C. Soil & Plant Amendment: There is no fee for permit registration, only for products:

1. \$25 for each product sold in packages of 10lbs or greater
2. \$75 for each product sold in packages of 10lbs or less, or 1 gallon or less
3. \$75 for products sold in both weight categories

- **Tonnage Reports:**

Tonnage reporting is required annually. Tonnage reports are due within 30 days of the close of each year, even if no sales were recorded. Late reports are assessed 10% penalty.

Important:

Delinquent tonnage reports, tonnage fees, and penalties must be received by our office before registrations will be approved and permits issued.
